The Root of Destructive Beliefs

Destructive beliefs often stem from negative experiences, such as rejection, failure, or abuse. Over time, these experiences distort our view of ourselves, and we "scam ourselves" by accepting lies as truth. These internal "fake news" stories play on repeat, convincing us we're not good enough, there's something wrong with us or we are unlovable. We get "scammed" out of our true identity and settle for self-destructive patterns in relationships.

The Impact of Internal Fake News


These false beliefs limit our potential and rob us of peace. In 2 Corinthians 10:5, we are urged to "take every thought captive and make it obedient to the mind of Christ." This means we must confront the lies we've been telling ourselves and be transformed by the truth God has for us. If we don't, these false beliefs will lock us into cycles of defeat.
